At the start of the year, I gathered with women at Pendeza Uganda, and later with over 50 people at the American Center, to pause and seek God’s direction for the year ahead. With scissors, magazines, and prayer, the room slowly filled with quiet reflection and honest conversations. As we created vision boards, scripture came alive in a practical way. “Write the vision and make it plain” (Habakkuk 2:2). What began as a simple activity became a moment of alignment as hearts opened to what God was placing before them.

As the boards took shape, so did clarity. Dreams moved from vague hopes to written intentions, anchored in faith. People spoke of purpose, healing, growth, and obedience, reminded that “Where there is no vision, the people perish” (Proverbs 29:18). In those moments, it was clear that vision boards are not about control, but about surrender. When we invite God into the process, He orders our steps and gives us the courage to walk confidently into what He has already prepared.



These sessions reaffirmed an important truth. When vision is rooted in God, action becomes intentional. And when people are guided to seek God for clarity, they are empowered to pursue their purpose with faith, confidence, and hope.
